

Transfer Agreements with Four-Year Colleges and Universities



Lord Fairfax Community College has a number of agreements with four-year colleges and universities that provide significant benefits to LFCC students. These “Transfer Agreements” provide clear pathways to help achieve goals of earning a bachelor’s degree.

What benefits do Transfer Agreements have?

These agreements pave the way for a smooth transition from LFCC to a four-year college or university. They also help maximize the number of transfer credits from LFCC to four-year institutions, in some cases resulting in acceptance as a junior after transfer from LFCC. A number of agreements also offer guaranteed acceptance as long as students achieve the required GPA during studies at LFCC.

How can I find out specific information about courses I should take to ensure transferability?

Faculty advisors can provide guidance about specific courses that are required by four-year institutions according to degrees and programs.
