⁴**Humanities Elective:** ART 100, 101, 102, 111, 112, 283, 284; ENG 241, 242, 243, 244, 251, 252, 255, 295; FRE 101, 102, 201, 202; GER 101, 102, 201, 202; Any HUM class; HIS 295; Any ITA class; MUS 121, 122; Any PHI class; Any REL class; SPA 101, 102, 201, 202. Depending on the requirements of four-year institutions, six to eight credit hours of a single foreign language may be appropriate. Contact your advisor and four-year institution representative.

⁵**Open Elective:** Any current course offering.

⁶**Literature:** Two semesters of American, British, or World literature are recommended; however, depending on the requirements of the four-year institution, two one-semester courses in different fields may be substituted with advisor's approval.

⁷**Science:** A one-year sequence of Biology, Chemistry, Geology, or Physics.

⁸**Social Science Elective:** ECO 120, 201, 202; GEO 210, 221, 222; HIS 111, 112, 121, 122; PLS 211, 212; Any PSY class; Any SOC class.

⁹**Computer Requirement:** ITE 115 or CSC 155; if you "test out" of this requirement, this becomes an open elective
