<b>APPLICATION DEADLINE</b>	<p>March 15 (new for fall 2015) – Fall semester transfer applicant deadline for general admission.</p> <p>March 15 – Fall semester transfer students applying for scholarship consideration. (<i>Scholarships are awarded to fall semester applicants only. To be eligible for transfer scholarship consideration: must be a Virginia Community College student and have a minimum of 4 semester credits by the deadline</i>)</p> <p>November 1 – Spring semester transfer applicant deadline for general admission.
